


## MONSTER MARATHON WAKIS








## JOÃO CAETANO THEATER






### **DELAY**


## PISTA DO 21 FAROL SANTANDER








## AÇÃO CEMBRA, PARATY























### **NAVALHA**

Solo exhibition held in 2014 at Galeria Choque Cultural, São Paulo, which included stencil works and interventions in public spaces. In addition to the exhibited pieces, the show featured tools used in the creation of stencils, such as masks and templates. The exhibition explored the edges of the system by allowing collectors to acquire the stencil template, enabling them to either reproduce the design or preserve the piece intact in their collection.





## **EXTROPICAL EXHIBITION**

Pera de Goma Gallery, Montevideo, Uruguay, 2014 A contemporary Brazilian visual art exhibition that questioned the idealized view of Brazil. Ten artists and collectives participated, exploring themes such as corruption, moralism, and abuse of power, offering a critique of the country's social and political reality.

that fosters and promotes culture in Atibaia, SP.










## ESPACIAL/CIGANO RISCA FACA EXHIBITION

Upon arriving at the exhibition site, visitors found photos of artworks that had been pasted on the streets of the city. Receiving a fanzine with a map, they were invited to locate and visit the sites of the artworks in the city, connecting the gallery experience with the artistic intervention in the urban space.


























### **MUTANTE**











































## EDUCATION WORKSHOPS AND LECTURES
